TRINITY NICHOLS SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

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Scholarships:

Each year that there are qualified high school seniors entering an institution of higher education, one or more monetary awards for such students may be presented. These awards recognize attendance and service to Trinity during the applicant's high school years. To qualify for an award, these criteria must be met:

- Applicants must be high school seniors at the time of application and must be going on to an institution of higher education.
- Academic performance of a B average or better is required.
- Applicants must supply a high school transcript.
- Applicants must be communicants in good standing at Trinity (or another Episcopal parish if applying for the Charles L. Dennis Scholarship).
- Applicants must complete and submit the Trinity Scholarship Application form no later than March 31st.
- The scholarship award will be made payable to the student upon receipt of evidence indicating first semester enrollment and will be issued at or before the beginning of the semester.

The availability of any scholarship awards to be given in a calendar year will be announced at the Annual Parish Meeting held on the third Sunday of each January.

Scholarship Committee:

Members:

When it appears that in January of any given year that there will be eligible candidates for scholarship awards, the Rector or Priest in Charge will form a committee composed of the Rector or Priest in Charge, a Warden, a Vestryperson, and a Parishioner in good standing chosen by the Vestry.

Meetings and Responsibilities:

The committee will meet as required to consider the availability of scholarship funding as determined by the Vestry and to choose one or more awardees from the eligible candidates who have completed their applications.

Applications must be submitted to the Parish Office no later than March 31st. Scholarship awards will be determined no later than May 31st.

Charles L. Dennis Scholarship:

In addition to the above criteria, awards of the Charles L. Dennis Scholarship will be given in the following order of preference:

- Children of the incumbent Rector or Priest in Charge
- Children of the paid staff of Trinity Church
- Members or children of members of Trinity Church

If, in any calendar year, there is no award of this scholarship, the monetary amount that would have been awarded shall be added to and become part of the principal of the Charles L. Dennis Scholarship Fund.
