On August 6, 2006, Transfiguration Sunday, the Reverend Ellen Kennedy officiated the service of Holy Eucharist for the first time as Vicar of Trinity Church.

Rev. Ellen comes to Trinity, from Calvary/St.George's Episcopal Church in Bridgeport where she held the position of Associate Priest for Program and Pastoral Care for more than three years. She was also the Bridgeport Coordinator for the Epiphany Program, a faith based mentoring program for ex-offenders. She is a very special individual; a priest of tremendous gifts and talents, with energy and enthusiasm. Her faith in God and her love for the Church has inspired all of us as we work together serving God.

Rev. Ellen is also presently licensed as a Registered Nurse in CT. Her formal education includes a Diploma in Nursing (1970) from St. Luke's School of Nursing, a Graduate in Education for Ministry (1994) from the University of the South School of Theology, and a Master of Divinity (2001) from Andover Newton Theological School. Prior to her call to ordained ministry, Rev. Ellen worked tirelessly in ministering to children as Church School teacher, Vacation Bible School Director, and Church School Director. To incorporate youth into the life of the parish is one of her personal goals. She has two adult daughters, Mary Ellen and Kathleen. Her personal hobbies include quilting, cooking and cake decorating.
